- Last Day to Register in Advance of Primary Election: July 24, 2018
 - Primary Election: August 14, 2018
- Absentee Balloting for General Election Begins: September 21, 2018
 - National Voter Registration Day: September 25, 2018
- Last Day to Register in Advance of General Election: October 16, 2018
 - General Election: November 6, 2018
