## Sexual Violence Center Presentations/Trainings

Our educational presentations/trainings cover a variety of topics related to sexual violence, including, but not limited to:

#### <u>SV(C) 101 and Responding to Disclosures (60-90 minutes)</u>

- This presentation is at a beginner level and is appropriate for folks without prior knowledge of sexual violence. Past audiences include teen parents and talk line volunteers.
- Topics covered: consent and sexual violence definitions, sexual violence umbrella, intro to rape culture, common trauma responses, tools for responding to sexual violence disclosures
- Participants will practice what they've learned through interactive scenarios tailored to the specific audience.

## <u>SV(C) 101 and Ready to ACT: Strategies for Bystander Intervention (60-90 minutes)</u>

- This presentation is at a beginner level and is appropriate for folks without prior knowledge of sexual violence. A past audience included residents of a permanent supportive housing facility.
- Topics covered: consent and sexual violence definitions, sexual violence umbrella, intro to rape culture, common trauma responses, basics of bystander invention
- Participants will practice what they've learned through interactive scenarios tailored to the specific audience.

#### <u>Ready to ACT: Strategies for Bystander Intervention and Responding to</u> <u>Disclosures (90-120 minutes)</u>

- This comprehensive training is well-suited for professionals seeking multiple tools to support their clients, students, or patients. Past audiences include professional health mentors and college RAs.
- Topics covered: consent and sexual violence definitions, sexual violence umbrella, intro to rape culture, common trauma responses, basics of bystander intervention, tools for responding to sexual violence disclosures.
- Participants will practice what they've learned through interactive scenarios tailored to the specific audience.

## <u>Healthy Relationships: Boundaries, Balance, & Mutual Respect (60-90 minutes)</u>

- This training is usually geared toward students. Past audiences include middle and high school students.
- Topics covered: consent and sexual violence, pillars of a healthy relationship, the abusive relationship cycle, deciding what's important to you in a relationship
- Highly interactive training: discussion questions and prompts are built in throughout this workshop.

#### <u>Tech Savvy & Safe in a Digital Dating Age (60 minutes)</u>

- This presentation is well-suited for youth, parents, or professionals working with youth. Past audiences include college students and professionals working with unhoused youth.
- Topics covered: digital consent, safe online dating etiquette, online dating red flags, and online harassment and stalking
